Calendar of Critical Dates

***An Addition from Mrs. Wulf, Counseling Director at MKCHS**

Dual Credit Registration Form due to Mrs. Wulf by **Friday, May 31st**

Mrs. Wulf will send signed Registration Forms, Kelly Transcripts, and certified PSAT scores to LU by the June 28th Deadline. If you are taking another test to meet the admission requirement after this May 31st deadline, you must send in your scores directly to LU by August 12th. All test reports other than PSAT are **only** accepted by LU directly from the testing agency. If you do not meet the testing requirement for LU admission over the summer you must complete Summer Reading for the Kelly English Course.

June

- 28** Dual Credit application deadline. **ALL** applications, course registration request forms, and transcripts must be submitted to the university by 5 p.m.

August

- 12** Final document deadline. **All** test scores (from summer entrance exams) must be in to the university by 5 p.m.
- 22** First payment deadline. Partial (half of balance) payment must be made to prevent being dropped.
- 26** **First class day**

September

- 2** Labor Day holiday
- 23** Final payment deadline – students who have not paid account balances will be dropped at 5 p.m.
- 24** Last day to drop without academic penalty
- 8** Last day to drop with academic penalty
- 28-29** Campus closed for Thanksgiving

December

- 2** **Last class day**
- 12** Final grades due by 1 p.m.

Tuition Information

- Reduced rate tuition for dual credit students in the Online program is \$133 per credit hour or \$399 for a 3 hour course. **However, a dual credit scholarship will be applied that lowers dual credit course costs to \$150 for a 3-hour course and \$200 for a 4-hour course. These scholarships are automatically generated and applied to students' accounts – no scholarship applications are necessary.**
- **Incentive for Exemplary Grades:** Students who earn final grades of A's or B's in their Fall 2019 dual credit courses will receive a discount on tuition for Spring 2020 dual credit courses. A final grade of an A or B in a fall dual credit course will result in a 50% tuition reduction in a spring dual credit course. This is a course-for-course incentive, and the financial benefits of this incentive are only applicable to the subsequent spring semester and will not carry over to future summer, fall, or spring semesters.
- Students who do not pay at least half of their tuition by the first payment deadline (August 22) will be dropped from courses.
