Calendar of Critical Dates

June

22 Dual Credit application deadline. **ALL** applications, course registration request forms, and transcripts must be submitted to the university by 5 p.m. No applications, course registration request forms, or transcripts will be accepted after this date.

August

13 Final document deadline. **All** test scores (from summer entrance exams) must be in to the university by 5 p.m.

23 First payment deadline. Partial (half of balance) payment must be made to prevent being dropped.

27 **First class day**

03 Labor Day holiday

24 Final payment deadline – students who have not paid account balances will be dropped at 5 p.m.

28 Last day to drop without academic penalty

Payment Information – NEWLY REDUCED TUITION RATES!

- Effective Summer 2018, dual credit tuition has been reduced to \$150 for a 3 semester hour course and \$200 for a 4 semester hour course. As part of the newly established “Gateway” program, students who earn a “B” in their first dual credit course will receive a \$75 scholarship for all subsequent courses (up to 18 credit hours) bringing the cost of the courses down to \$75 for a 3 hour course and \$125 for a 4 hour course. *Students must earn at least a “B” in all Gateway courses and may only take up to 18 semester credit hours in this program.* Courses taken above the 18 credit hour limit will be billed at \$150/3 hour course and \$200/4 hour course. LEAP courses are not a part of the Gateway program. Students with unpaid balances at the end of a semester will not be enrolled in future courses until the balance is paid in full.
- Students who do not pay at least half of their tuition by the first payment deadline (August 23) will be dropped from courses.
